Dog bite cases fall under the legal category of "premises liability." Premises liability law states that people are responsible for any injuries resulting from dangers associated with their property. [Slips and falls](#) are another type of premises liability litigation.

Under the law, it is very difficult for dog owners to escape liability when their animal injures someone. They cannot get out of paying compensation simply by saying that the victim provoked the animal, or that the dog was on a leash or that the dog had never bitten anyone before.

Dog bite litigation can involve some very serious injuries, and often involve children.
