About Workers' Compensation

When you have been injured at work or in the course of a work activity, **you have the right to see a doctor** and to be paid for the time you miss. You also have the right to file for workers' compensation and the right to talk with a lawyer of your choosing. The company you work for cannot legally punish you in any way for doing so.

Often, after a lawyer analyzes a situation, he or she will discover other parties are also at fault for your injury. For example, many people are injured in construction accidents that are partially the fault of someone besides their employer, such as other contractors. In these cases, the attorney can often file a third party injury claim, which can mean additional compensation for you.
